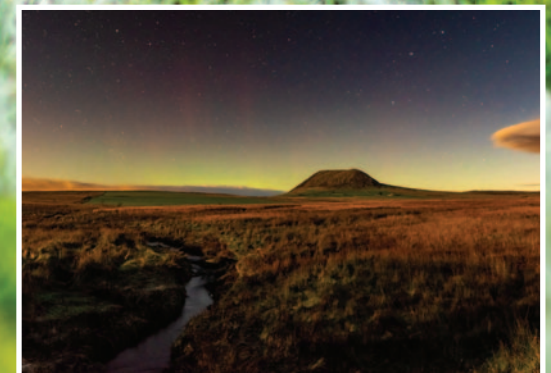
The 2026 Budget Energy SuperCupNI will see some of the world's best youth teams descend upon Northern Ireland for a football extravaganza .



VENUES/ LOCATION

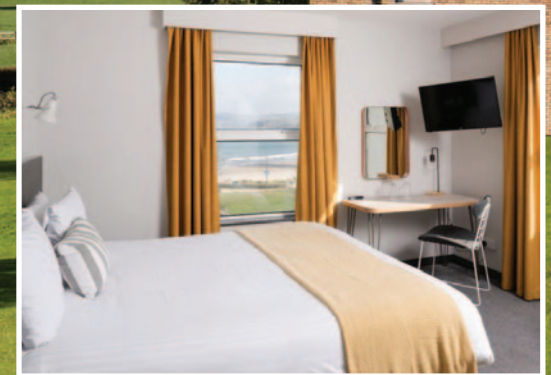
The tournament will take place across 14 high quality venues (one 3G pitch, with remainder natural grass surfaces).

The tournament also takes place in the one of the most picturesque areas on the island of Ireland.



ACCOMMODATION

Visiting teams will stay in high quality accommodation including local hotels (3 star and 4 star), guesthouses, high quality youth hostels and modern and welcoming University accommodation.



TOURNAMENT FORMAT

The tournament starts with the Welcome Parade and Opening Ceremony on Sunday 26th July.

Teams will then be placed into groups of 4 and play 3 group games between Monday to Wednesday.

On Thursday all teams will play in a semi-final, with the tournament concluding with 'finals day' on Friday 31st July. All teams are guaranteed 5 games (one daily).

Games in the Premier and Junior Sections will be 35 minutes each way (70 minutes); Minor Section games will be 30 minutes each way (60 minutes).

ENTRY INFO

- The deadline for applications for the boys-tournament is Friday 31st October 2025.
- £200 UK Sterling must be paid to the tournament upon submission of the application form as we share the tournament's banking details for an online bank transfer.
- If entry is confirmed, a deposit of £2000 (UK Sterling) is payable by 14th March 2026 towards the cost of the team's accommodation. Teams not having paid this deposit will not be included in the draw.
