POLICY STATEMENT

SCNI aims to ensure that all young people participating in the tournament have information about the various sources of help and advice available.

Don't let anyone spoil the fun - SCNI is a well established tournament with high quality teams but we want to ensure it remains fun and safe for all the young people involved.

Speak out - If you have a concern or worry, you could speak to an adult you know and trust. If you feel there is no one you can talk to or contact you may find the following organisations helpful:

	ChildLine is the UK's free, confidential 24-hour helpline for children and young people in distress or danger. ChildLine is a service provided by the NSPCC. <u>www.childline.org.uk</u>
Northern Health and Social Care Trust.	This is the statutory agency responsible for child protection in the majority of the area SCNI will take place.
